



Retractable Plates Care and Maintenance & Warranty

CARE AND MAINTENANCE

We're glad you're getting the best out of your vehicle. Below please read and review the information below on how to maintain, care and protect your newly installed retractable/hideaway plate frames.

1. Ground Objects

When on the road, try to stay clear from debris, including but not limited to: Road kill, tire peels, trash, potholes.

2. Speed humps

Most speed humps are raised and being that the plate sits low, you must go over them carefully.

3. Parking pavement

It is highly recommended that the vehicle be parked backed in at areas where pavement separates cars facing each other. Most pavement separators are intentionally raised high to prevent bumper to bumper damaged during parking.

4. Manual operation

Pulling the plate frame out manually will cause the cables to twist.

NOTE: IF A PLATE IS DAMAGED OR BENT FROM ANY CAUSES DESCRIBED ABOVE AND ANY SIMILAR CAUSES ON EITHER THE FRAMES OR THE REMOTE OR ITS ASSEMBLY, IT DOES NOT FALL UNDER THE WARRANTY. PRODUCT AND/OR INSTALL IS NON-REFUNDABLE AND NON-RETURNABLE UNLESS IT IS FOUND TO BE DEFECTIVE AS DESCRIBED BELOW. ACCIDENTS ARE NOT COVERED BY WARRANTY.

WARRANTY

Parts are warranted for 30 days from original date of purchase. If a plate is found to be defective, please advise your service rep or the dealer where you purchased them to claim a warranty. Manufacture will then test and make a decision to determine whether they are defective or if it is neglect issue.
